## WAYS TO REGISTER

Payment methods accepted include cash, checks, money orders, MasterCard, VISA, and Discover.

On a credit card registration, please include the card number, expiration date, security code, printed name as it appears on the card, and your signature.

Make all checks payable to JC Parks.

You may create an account online if you are a new customer. If you are an established customer but don't know your login information, your user name and password can be emailed to you if you have an email address on file.

### Scholarships

The Parks and Recreation Commission believes that no youth should be denied access to Parks and Recreation programs for financial reasons.

The Parks and Recreation Foundation makes recreation scholarships available to those who otherwise would not be able to afford to participate in organized recreation activities. Those seeking scholarships will be asked to complete a Recreation Scholarship Application Form available through JC Parks. Scholarships are generally limited to those receiving benefits from public assistance as designated on the application form. Scholarship funding is limited to \$200 per individual per calendar year and is restricted to ongoing programs conducted by JC Parks staff. Specialized programs of short duration conducted by non-staff members (e.g. baseball clinics) are ineligible for scholarship funding.

All application forms requesting funding for youth programs must be signed by the parent/guardian of the prospective participant. Participants/parents must pay a minimum of 20% of the registration fee for programs for which scholarship assistance is requested.

## Refund Policy

Program cancellations may be made Mon - Fri, 8am-5pm, by calling (573) 634-6482 or in person at 1299 Lafayette Street. The Parks and Recreation Commission has adopted the following refund policy regarding programs and facilities:

### Programs

1. If a cancellation is made prior to the registration deadline, a refund will be given, less a processing fee: \$10 for program fees up to \$99; \$20 for program fees \$100 & over.
2. If a cancellation is made after the registration deadline, a credit for future programs/reservations will be given for 1/2 of the fee paid. Once a program starts no refund/credit will be given unless a medical statement substantiates the injury or illness.
3. Fees paid for team registrations are not refundable once a team registration has been accepted and recorded except as in #6 below.
4. No credits, refunds, or make-up classes will be issued for programs missed due to personal reasons.
5. A refund or credit will be granted when medical illnesses/injuries are substantiated by a medical note.
6. Full refunds are made if a program is canceled by JC Parks.

### Camps

1. Cancellations will be given a refund or household credit to be used for future programs/reservations.
2. A \$25 fee will be charged per week, per child for every refund issued.
3. All camp refunds must be requested two weeks prior to the first day of the program.
4. If a cancellation is made after the registration deadline, a refund will be given for 1/2 of the fee paid.
5. Once a program starts, no refund or credit will be given unless a medical note substantiates an injury/illness.
6. Camp transfers: after the registration deadline, a \$10 transfer fee will be charged per week, per child.

### Facilities/Hayrides

1. Fees paid for admission to park facilities are not refundable.
2. The holding fee required to reserve park facilities/shelters is not refundable under any circumstance except as in #5 below.
3. If a cancellation occurs ten or more business days prior to the scheduled reservation, the facility/hayride rental fee and deposit is refundable, less a \$10 processing fee.
4. If a cancellation occurs less than ten business days prior to the reservation, 1/2 of the rental fee and the entire damage deposit will be refunded.
5. Full refunds are made if a rental is canceled by JC Parks.

### Pool Rentals

1. Weather cancellations are at the discretion of JC Parks Aquatics staff.
2. Reservation fees for pools are not refundable under any circumstance except as in #4 below.
3. Transfer of rental date must be requested two weeks prior to reservation date.
4. Full refunds are made if a rental is canceled by JC Parks.

### Pool Passes

No refunds will be issued for summer pool passes.

### Amusement Park Tickets

All amusement park ticket sales are final. Refunds are not issued for amusement park tickets.

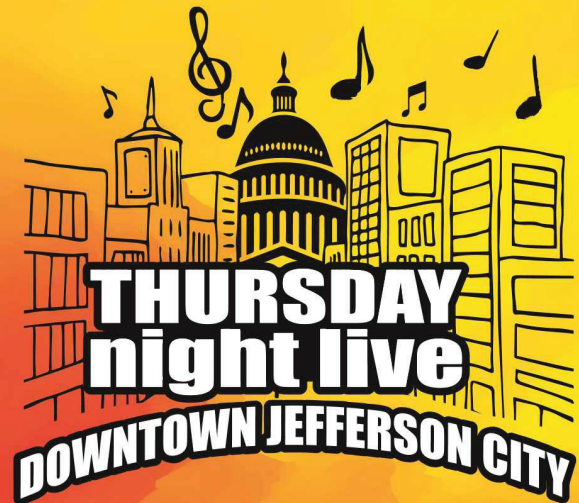

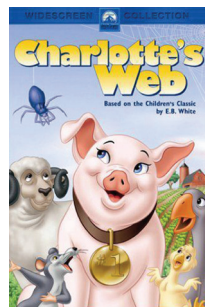

## Group Swim Lesson Levels

### Parent and Child

Ages 6 months - 2 years

**Class length: 30 minutes; Depth: 4.5 feet**

Children will develop a comfort level in and around the water. It will provide the parent with the necessary knowledge and skills to orient the child to the water and safely supervise water activities. One adult must accompany the child in the water.

### Preschool

Ages 3 - 4 years

**Class length: 30 minutes; Depth: varies**

Children gain greater independence in their skills and develop more comfort in and around the water. Swimmers will put their faces under water.

### Learn-to-Swim

Ages 5 + years

**Class length: 45 minutes; Depth: varies**

**Level 1: Introduction to Water Skills** is for a first-time swimmer. Enter and exit water safely. Practice putting face in water and blowing bubbles through mouth and nose. Front and back glide, back float. Explore arm and hand movements.

**Level 2: Fundamental Aquatic Skills** Fully submerge and hold breath. Float on front and back. Roll over from front to back, back to front. Glide on front and back. Tread water. Combine arm and leg actions on back and front.

**Level 3: Stroke Development** Enter water by jumping from side. Rotary breathing. Change from vertical to horizontal position on front and back. Front crawl and elementary back stroke. Flutter, dolphin and scissors kick. Head first entries from sitting/kneeling position.

**Level 4: Stroke Improvement** Swim underwater. Front and back crawl. Elementary back stroke. Breaststroke, sidestroke, and butterfly. Front crawl and backstroke open turns. feet first surface dive and survival swimming.

**Level 5: Stroke Refinement** Front and back crawl. Elementary backstroke. Breaststroke, sidestroke, and butterfly. Tuck and pike surface dives. Front flip and backstroke flip turn. Rescue breathing. Shallow angle dive. Safety topics and more.

**Level 6: Swimming and Skill Proficiency** Fitness swimmer. Personal water safety and fundamentals of diving.

**Level 7: Competitive Swimming** *Pre-requisite: must be able to swim 25 yards of freestyle and backstroke.* Freestyle, backstroke, breaststroke, butterfly, turns, and endurance swimming. Available at Ellis-Porter Riverside during select session times. Class is dependent on instructor availability.

## StarGuard Lifeguard Training

JC Parks aquatic staff is trained with StarGuard lifeguard training program, which provides necessary license to work at JC Parks aquatic facilities.

Participants learn to anticipate, recognize, and manage accidents/incidents in a professional manner while protecting themselves. Training includes performing rescues and emergency care. Course includes first aid, CPR, oxygen administration, and AED administration.

**New Guard classes** require completion of an online course prior to class start date. Participants will be notified when course materials are available for pick-up.

**Returning Guards** must have proof of current certification.

**In-Water Training** is required in addition to classroom time. Available dates are May 22, May 23, May 24, May 27, or May 28 (JC Parks staff only date). Sign up for your preferred in-water training date when you attend classroom training.

## Pool Policy and Procedure

### General

- Pools are open daily except during threatening weather or when projected high air temperature is 74 degrees or cooler.
- Certified lifeguards are on duty at all times for your safety.
- During periods of low attendance, various attractions and/or pools within the complex may close.
- During periods of extreme heat or high temperatures, staff will take 10 minute safety breaks throughout day to clear pool.
- JC Parks is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Coin operated lockers are available at each facility.
- Complimentary lifejackets are available at the admission booth.
- Diaper changing stations are available in the restrooms.
- It is the patron's responsibility to read and obey all posted signs for safety.

### Facility Rules

- Profane language is not allowed. Patrons using inappropriate language will be asked to exit the facility for the day **without a refund**.
- All patrons must pay to enter whether swimming or observing.
- Pool patrons are not allowed to leave and re-enter the pools. Exceptions made for adults with manager's approval.
- Patrons wearing street clothes will not be allowed admission into facility unless as a guardian of a child 10 years or younger.
- Appropriate swim attire must be worn, including male swim trunks, female one or two piece suits and tankinis. Suits should not be see through. No thongs, pants, jean shorts or shorts with belt loops or rivets, inappropriate language, and anything else deemed not appropriate by pool staff.
- Children 10 years and under **MUST** be accompanied and supervised by a person 15 years of age or older.
- Outside food, drink, coolers or glass containers are not allowed into the pools.
- JC Parks reserves the right to check baggage if necessary.
- Persons must be able to swim on their own to use waterslides.
- Paging patrons is not permitted.
- No smoking/vaping in the pool complex or parking lot.
- Any person suspected to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be permitted into the facility.
- Water wings/small inner tubes are permitted if parent/guardian is within reach of the child. **NO Rafts/large inner tubes.** Noodles are allowed into the facility.
- Close fitting swim diapers are required for those not potty trained. Swim diapers are available for purchase.
- If you, your child, or anyone in your family has had diarrhea in the past two weeks, please do not use the pool.
- Lifeguards and managers have final authority.

### Clear Bag Policy

JC Parks has implemented a clear bag policy at Memorial Park Family Aquatic Center and Ellis-Porter Riverside Pool **during public session hours**.

This policy supports our priority to create a fun and safe environment for our pool guests and staff.

Each patron may bring one clear bag of any size. Mesh bags are also acceptable.

In addition to a clear/mesh bag, patrons may bring in a small clutch that does not exceed 4.5" x 6.5".

### Clear Bag FAQs

**Q. Will I be able to purchase a clear bag at the pool?**

A. Both pools will have reusable clear totes available for purchase at the admission gates. Visit [JCParks.com](http://JCParks.com) for purchase fees and options.

**Q. What do I do if I have medical equipment?**

A. Pool staff will be on-hand to assist guests who have medically necessary items, including breastfeeding supplies. Refrigeration is available if needed.

**Q. What about beach towels?**

A. We ask that guests remove towels from their bags and carry towels over their shoulders or arms when entering the facility.

**Q. Are diaper bags allowed?**

A. No. Any supplies needed are required to be in a clear bag. Each member of a family, including children, will be allowed to bring an approved clear bag and a clutch purse into the pool.

### Non-Approved Bags
