Over the years, civic-minded individuals and organizations have maintained a tradition of enhancing the quality of life for their families, friends, and neighbors through generous donations to the Jefferson City Parks and Recreation system. In 1992, the Jefferson City Parks and Recreation Foundation was formed to provide continuing leadership and foster the expansion of parks and recreation services in Jefferson City.

The foundation's goal is to emphasize the value of parks and recreation - both passive and active - not only for individual growth and development, but also for a strong family unit and for making our community a more desirable place to live, work, play, and visit.

## Scholarships

The Jefferson City Parks and Recreation Commission ensures no youth is excluded from its programs due to financial barriers. Recreation scholarships, funded by the Parks and Recreation Foundation, are available through a simple application process. Eligibility typically requires public assistance benefits, with annual funding capped at \$200 per individual for JC Parks-run programs. Short-term, non-staff-led programs like clinics are excluded. Applications must be signed by a parent/guardian, and participants contribute at least 20% of program fees.

## Registering for Programs

We aim to make registering for programs easy by providing several different ways to sign up for the activities you enjoy:

### 1. Walk-in

Register in-person by visiting The Linc during open hours at 1299 Lafayette Street, Jefferson City MO, 65101

### 2. Register by mail

Mail your registration form and check made payable to JC Parks (do not mail cash) to The Linc at 1299 Lafayette Street, Jefferson City MO 65101

### 3. Register by phone

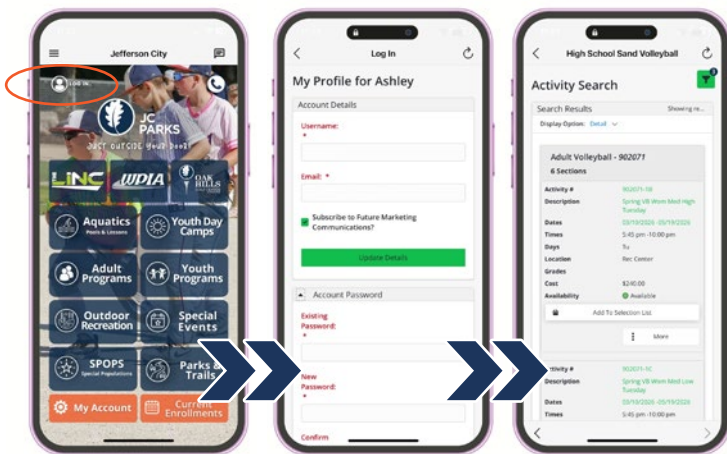
Call us at 573-634-6482 to register over the phone; we accept MasterCard, VISA, or Discover for registration fees; have your program, session, and Activity # handy.

### 4. Register online

Visit us online at JCParks.com, locate your desired activity and create an account through our registration system, RecTrac.

### 5. Use the JC Parks App

Download the “JC Parks” app from the Apple App Store or Google Play. Log in (or create an account) using your RecTrac info—our **single sign-on** means you’ll stay logged in as you move through the app. Browse programs, choose sessions for each family member, add them to your cart, and check out right from your phone. Fast, simple, and right in your pocket.



## Refund Policies

Program cancellations may be made Mon - Fri, 8am-5pm, by calling (573) 634-6482 or in person at 1299 Lafayette Street. The Parks and Recreation Commission has adopted the following refund policy regarding programs and facilities:

### PROGRAMS

1. If a cancellation is made prior to the registration deadline, a refund will be given, less a processing fee: \$10 for program fees up to \$99; \$20 for program fees \$100 & over.
2. If a cancellation is made after the registration deadline, a credit for future programs/reservations will be given for 1/2 of the fee paid. Once a program starts no refund/credit will be given unless a medical statement substantiates the injury or illness.
3. Fees paid for team registrations are not refundable once a team registration has been accepted and recorded except as in #6 below.
4. No credits, refunds, or make-up classes will be issued for programs missed due to personal reasons.
5. A refund or credit will be granted when medical illnesses/injuries are substantiated by a medical note.
6. Full refunds are made if a program is canceled by JC Parks.

### CAMPS

1. A \$25 processing fee will be charged per week, per child for every refund issued.
2. All camp refunds must be requested two weeks prior to the first day of the program.
3. If a cancellation is made after the registration deadline, a refund will be given for 1/2 of the fee paid.
4. Once a program starts, no refund will be given unless a medical statement substantiates the injury/illness.
5. Camp transfers need to be approved by the Program Manager, Angie Toeppen. Send requests to atoeppen@jeffersoncitymo.gov.

### FACILITIES/HAYRIDES

1. Fees paid for admission to park facilities are not refundable.
2. The holding fee required to reserve park facilities/shelters is not refundable under any circumstance except as in #5 below.
3. If a cancellation occurs ten or more business days prior to the scheduled reservation, the facility/hayride rental fee and deposit is refundable, less a \$10 processing fee.
4. If a cancellation occurs less than ten business days prior to the reservation, 1/2 of the rental fee and the entire damage deposit will be refunded.
5. Full refunds are made if a rental is canceled by JC Parks.

### POOL RENTALS

1. Weather cancellations are at the discretion of JC Parks Aquatics staff.
2. Reservation fees for pools are not refundable under any circumstance except as in #4 below.
3. Transfer of rental date must be requested two weeks prior to reservation date.
4. Full refunds are made if a rental is canceled by JC Parks.

### AMUSEMENT PARK TICKETS

JC Parks offers discount amusement park tickets, call 573-634-6482 for more information. All amusement park ticket sales are final. Refunds are not issued for amusement park tickets.

## Late Fees

Many parks and recreation programs have enrollment limits and registration deadlines. To ensure a spot in your favorite activity, please be sure to register before the registration deadline. Registering early allows staff to prepare and gather supplies. If space is still available in a program after the registration deadline, late fees may apply.

## LIABILITY

JC Parks and/or the Jefferson City Parks and Recreation Commission does not provide insurance coverage for injuries suffered while participating in programs or using facilities. Any costs related to such injuries should be presented to your personal medical insurance carrier.

**Level 1: Introduction to Water Skills** is for a first-time swimmer. Enter and exit water safely. Practice putting face in water and blowing bubbles through mouth and nose. Front and back glide, back float. Explore arm and hand movements.

**Level 3: Stroke Development** Enter water by jumping from side. Rotary breathing. Change from vertical to horizontal position on front and back. Front crawl and elementary back stroke. Flutter, dolphin and scissors kick. Head first entries from sitting/kneeling.

**Level 4: Stroke Improvement** Swim underwater. Front and back crawl. Elementary back stroke. Breaststroke, sidestroke, and butterfly. Front crawl and backstroke open turns. feet first surface dive and survival swimming.

**Level 5: Stroke Refinement** Front and back crawl. Elementary backstroke. Breaststroke, sidestroke, and butterfly. Tuck and pike surface dives. Front flip and backstroke flip turn. Rescue breathing. Shallow angle dive. Safety topics and more.

**Level 6: Swimming and Skill Proficiency** Fitness swimmer. Personal water safety and fundamentals of diving.

**Level 7: Competitive Swimming** *Pre-requisite: must be able to swim 25 yards of freestyle and backstroke.* Freestyle, backstroke, breaststroke, butterfly, turns, and endurance swimming. Class is dependent on instructor availability.

## General Policies

- Pools are open daily except during threatening weather.
- Certified lifeguards are on duty at all times for your safety.
- During periods of low attendance, various attractions and/or pools within the complex may close.
- During periods of extreme heat, staff will take 10 minute safety breaks throughout day to clear pool.
- JC Parks is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Coin operated lockers are available and recommended at each facility.
- Complimentary life jackets available at the admission booth.
- Diaper changing stations are available in the restrooms.
- It is the patron's responsibility to read and obey all posted signs for safety.

## Facility Rules

- Profane language is not allowed. Patrons using inappropriate language will be asked to exit the facility for the day **without a refund**.
- Children under 7 years old should be within an arm's length of parent/guardian while in the water at all times.
- All patrons must pay to enter whether swimming or observing.
- Pool patrons are allowed to leave and re-enter the pools and must have a wrist-band for re-entry.
- Patrons wearing street clothes will not be allowed admission into facility unless as a guardian of a child 10 years or younger.
- Appropriate swim attire must be worn, including male swim trunks, female one or two piece suits and tankinis. Suits should not be see through. No thongs, pants, jean shorts or shorts with belt loops or rivets, inappropriate language, and anything else deemed not appropriate by pool staff.
- Children 12 years and under **MUST** be accompanied and supervised by a person **16 years of age or older**.
- Outside food, drink, coolers or glass containers are not allowed into the pools.
- JC Parks reserves the right to check baggage if necessary.
- Persons must be able to swim on their own to use waterslides.
- Paging patrons is not permitted.
- No smoking/vaping in the pool complex or parking lot.
- Any person suspected to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be permitted into the facility.
- Water wings/small inner tubes are permitted if parent/guardian is within reach of the child. **NO Rafts/large inner tubes.** Noodles are allowed into the facility.
- Footballs/basketballs are not allowed.
- Close fitting swim diapers are required for those not potty trained. Swim diapers are available for purchase.
- If you, your child, or anyone in your family has had diarrhea in the past two weeks, please do not use the pool.
- Lifeguards and managers have final authority.

## Clear Bag Policy

JC Parks has a clear bag policy at Memorial Park Family Aquatic Center and Ellis-Porter Riverside Pool during public session hours.

This policy supports our priority to create a fun and safe environment for our pool guests and staff.

Each patron may bring one clear bag of any size. Mesh bags are also acceptable.

In addition to a clear/mesh bag, patrons may bring in a small clutch that does not exceed 4.5" x 6.5".

### Clear Bag FAQs

*Q. Will I be able to purchase a clear bag at the pool?*

A. Both pools will have reusable clear totes available for purchase at the admission gates. Visit [JCParks.com](http://JCParks.com) for purchase fees and options.

A. Pool staff will be on-hand to assist guests who have medically necessary items, including breastfeeding supplies. Refrigeration is available if needed.

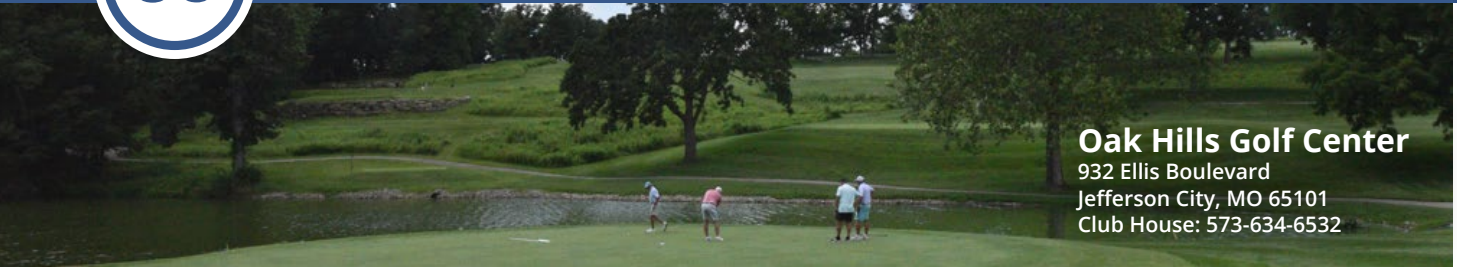

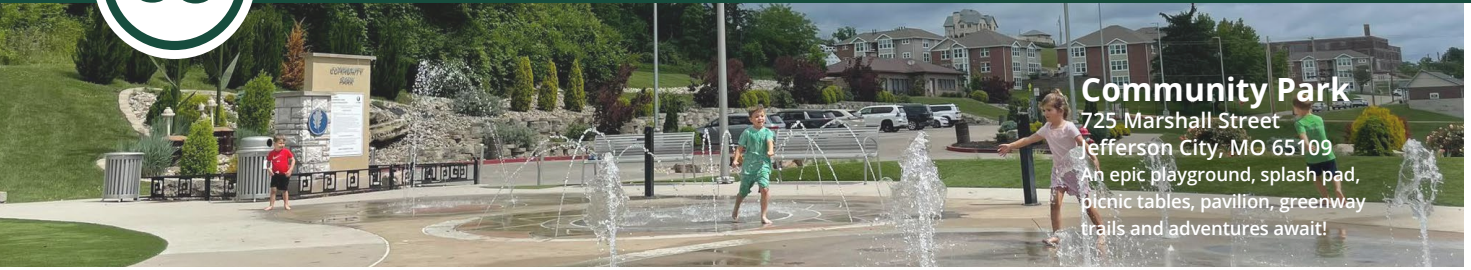

JC Parks is just outside your door with facilities that are ready for you to enjoy! Public parks, trails, and facilities are open year-round from 5:00 AM to 10:00 PM, unless otherwise noted on park signage or here in the program guide (neighborhood parks, for example, close at sunset).

Our department maintains:

- 20 parks that cover 1,400 acres of parkland
- 40 miles of trails
- 17 ball fields
- 13 playgrounds
- 2 swimming pools
- 1 public golf course
- 1 wellness and recreation center
- 1 one-sheet indoor ice arena
- 1 outdoor amphitheater

## Forestry

Trees play an invaluable role in our park system! Jefferson City forestry staff, including one ISA-certified arborist, have the important task of planting and maintaining city trees as well as mowing hundreds of acres each week in the park system.

### Right of Way Trees

Under the tree care ordinance passed in March of 1998, the JC Parks was assigned responsibility for the tree care of all City-owned trees. Since that time, most of the community's street trees have been inventoried and the most critical needs have been addressed.

Anyone needing to plant, remove, or prune trees in city right-of-way must have prior approval from the City Forester. Please contact JC Parks with questions.

### Memorial Trees

Can't decide what to get Mom and Dad for their upcoming anniversary? Looking for a lasting remembrance of a loved one? Want a unique way to celebrate the birth of your child? Through the **Jefferson City Parks and Recreation Foundation** you can establish a living memorial and beautify your parks at the same time!

**McKay Lake:** This neighborhood fishing lake at McKay Park is perfect for bank fishing or hand-launched non-motorized boats. You'll find bass, bluegill, catfish, crappie, and seasonal trout stocked for the Winter Trout Program.

**Hough Lake:** A quieter option tucked into Hough Park, Hough Lake offers anglers a peaceful spot to cast for bass, catfish, bluegill, and other warm-water fish along its shores.

## Launch Your Boat

Grab your poles and paddles, we've got four places to launch your boat and enjoy time on the water:

**Binder Lake Boat Ramp:** Binder Lake boat ramp sports "rougher" texture that eliminates slipping on the moss during the summer. The ramp is at a greater pitch which makes loading and unloading much easier.

**Missouri River Access:** The river has always been right in our backyard. Now it is easily accessible! Wilson's Serenity Point at Carl R. Noren Missouri River Access, located in North Jefferson Recreation Area, is open from 5:00 AM to 10:00 PM.

**Hough Park Lake:** boating (hand-launched) and bank fishing are permitted at Hough Park Lake. Access to the golf course irrigation lake is at the end of Iven Road. For personal safety, fishing and boating are not allowed near hole #3 on the north end of lake.

## RECYCLING BASICS

Recycling is easy with single-stream collection using your gray-top can! Just toss approved items into one container:

- **Metals:** Aluminum and tin cans, trays, foils, and empty aerosol cans.
- **Paper:** Newspapers, magazines, junk mail, and tearable paper.
- **Cardboard:** Pizza, gift, cereal, and cake boxes (no food residue).
- **Plastics:** Only #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, and #7 containers.
- **Rinse Items:** Remove food residue before recycling.
- **No Plastic Bags or Glass:** Keep these out of your bin.
- **No Styrofoam:** Foam cups, plates, and utensils aren't accepted.
- **Avoid Hazardous Waste:** No motor oil or chemicals.
- **Keep It Clean & Recycle Right:** Contaminated items disrupt the process. When in doubt, stick to the basics!

## GLASS RECYCLING

Glass food and beverage containers of any color are accepted at drop-off locations. No need to sort or remove labels—just place lids back on. Items like Pyrex, ceramics, window glass, toilets, and TVs are not accepted.



For reusable items, consider donating them to Habitat for Humanity.

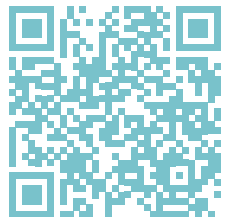

### Where does the glass go?

Glass to be recycled is consolidated at a city facility and then sent via tractor trailer to Ripple Glass in Kansas City, MO. Upon arriving at Ripple, glass is cleaned, sorted and crushed into cullet. The cleaned cullet is then made into insulation or new glass bottles.

## BULKY TRASH PICKUP DATES

For single-family homes, duplexes, triplexes, and townhouses with residential cart service through Republic Services within Jefferson City limits. Place items on the curb no earlier than Sunday before your pick-up date and no later than 5:00 A.M. Monday.

Trash and recycling carts will be collected on normal days, and small items must fit in your trash cart. Be patient—items will be collected by the last day.

## HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Household hazardous waste includes leftover products with corrosive, toxic, flammable, or reactive ingredients. Improper disposal can harm soil, air, water, and ecosystems. To address this, Cole County, Jefferson City, and Republic Services opened the Household Hazardous Waste Facility in 2011. It serves all Cole County residents, ensuring proper disposal of over 20,000 lbs. of waste. No commercial waste—residential use only.
