## K-1:

When a change of possession occurs, the team gaining possession must dribble or pass the ball (without pressure) past the three point line and check it with the opposing team before play begins. After checking the ball, a player cannot dribble or shoot to start play. The player with the ball must pass to a teammate outside the lane. Any first pass made in the lane may result in a turnover. The defense must allow the first pass to be made as long as it is outside the lane.

## All Grades:

Each player must receive equal playing time, which should be at least 16 minutes per game.
Rough play will not be allowed. Players will be removed from the game if fouls are intentional.
