Refund Policy

Program cancellations may be made Mon - Fri, 8am-5pm, by calling (573) 634-6482 or in person at 1299 Lafayette Street. The Parks and Recreation Commission has adopted the following refund policy regarding programs and facilities:

Programs

1. If a cancellation is made prior to the registration deadline, a refund will be given, less a processing fee: \$10 for program fees up to \$99; \$20 for program fees \$100 & over.

If a cancellation is made after the registration deadline, a credit for future programs/reservations will be given for 1/2 of the fee paid. Once a program starts no refund/credit will be given unless a medical statement substantiates the injury or illness.
Fees paid for team registrations are not refundable once a team registration has been accepted and recorded except as in #6 below.

4. No credits, refunds, or make-up classes will be issued for programs missed due to personal reasons.

5. A refund or credit will be granted when medical illnesses/ injuries are substantiated by a medical note.

6. Full refunds are made if a program is canceled by JC Parks.

Camps

1. A \$25 processing fee will be charged per week, per child for every refund issued.

3. All camp refunds must be requested two weeks prior to the first day of the program.

4. If a cancellation is made after the registration deadline, a refund will be given for 1/2 of the fee paid.

5. Once a program starts, no refund will be given unless a medical statement substantiates the injury/illness.

6. Camp transfers need to be approved by the Program Manager, Angie Toebben. Requests need to be sent directly to atoebben@jeffersoncitymo.gov

Facilities/Hayrides

1. Fees paid for admission to park facilities are not refundable. 2. The holding fee required to reserve park facilities/shelters is

not refundable under any circumstance except as in #5 below.

3. If a cancellation occurs ten or more business days prior to the scheduled reservation, the facility/hayride rental fee and deposit is refundable, less a \$10 processing fee.

4. If a cancellation occurs less than ten business days prior to the reservation, 1/2 of the rental fee and the entire damage deposit will be refunded.

5. Full refunds are made if a rental is canceled by JC Parks.

Pool Rentals

1. Weather cancellations are at the discretion of JC Parks Aquatics staff.

2. Reservation fees for pools are not refundable under any circumstance except as in #4 below.

3. Transfer of rental date must be requested two weeks prior to reservation date.

4. Full refunds are made if a rental is canceled by JC Parks.

Amusement Park Tickets

All amusement park ticket sales are final. Refunds are not issued for amusement park tickets.

Payment methods accepted include cash, checks, money orders, MasterCard, VISA, and Discover.

On a credit card registration, please include the card number, expiration date, security code, printed name as it appears on the card, and your signature.

JC Parks and/or the Jefferson City Parks and Recreation Commission does not provide insurance coverage for injuries suffered while participating in programs or using facilities.

Any costs related to such injuries should be presented to your personal medical insurance carrier.

LATE FEE POLICY

Many parks and recreation programs have enrollment limits and registration deadlines. To ensure a spot in your favorite activity, please be sure to register before the registration deadline. Registering early will allow for proper staffing levels and adequate equipment and program supplies for all participants and will save you money.

If space is still available in a program after the registration deadline, the program fees will be higher.



Scholarships

The Jefferson City Parks and Recreation Commission believes that no youth should be denied access to Parks and Recreation programs for financial reasons.

The Parks and Recreation Foundation makes recreation scholarships available to those who otherwise would not be able to afford to participate in organized recreation activities. Those seeking scholarships will be asked to complete a **Recreation Scholarship Application Form** available through JC Parks. Scholarships are generally limited to those receiving benefits from public assistance as designated on the application form. Scholarship funding is limited to \$200 per individual per calendar year and is restricted to ongoing programs conducted by JC Parks staff. Specialized programs of short duration conducted by non-staff members (e.g. baseball clinics) are ineligible for scholarship funding.

All application forms requesting funding for youth programs must be signed by the parent/guardian of the prospective participant. Participants/parents must pay a minimum of 20% of the registration fee for programs for which scholarship assistance is requested.

Located in North Jefferson Recreation Area, this 2 acre dog park offers a fenced, off leash area for dogs to stretch their legs and exercise.

Includes a double gate entrance, water source, waste disposal stations, posted regulations and use guidelines, and park benches throughout the site.

Launch Your Boat

Binder Lake Boat Ramp: Binder Lake boat ramp sports a "rougher" texture that eliminates slipping on the moss during the summer. The ramp is at a greater pitch which makes loading and unloading much easier.

Missouri River Access: The river has always been right in our backyard. Now it is easily accessible! Wilson's Serenity Point at Carl R. Noren Missouri River Access, located in North lefferson Recreation Area, is open from 5:00am to 11:00pm.

Hough Park Lake: boating (hand-launched) and bank fishing are permitted at Hough Park Lake. Access to the golf course irrigation lake is at the end of Iven Road. For personal safety, fishing and boating are not allowed near hole #3 on the north end of lake.

McKay Park Lake: In addition to bank fishing, hand-launched boating is now permitted at McKay Park Lake. Bring your favorite non-motorized water vessel during park hours of 5:00am to 11:00pm. All vehicles and trailers must remain in designated parking lots and roadways as they are not permitted on trails or grass areas.



RV Camping

Fee: \$26/Day (all sites full hook-up) Fee will increase to \$30/Day starting Nov. 1, 2023

The campground has 17 RV campsites with full water, sewer, and electrical hookups. Check-in is 2:00pm; check-out is 1:00pm.

Reservations can be made up to a year in advance. Contact bindercamper@gmail.com or (573) 636-0665 to reach the campground host.

They also feature barbecue grills, covered picnic tables, campfire rings, and a laundry and shower house.

Community Bike Rides

Community bike rides are free and open to anyone looking for a group laid-back cyclists to ride with. These rides are a great way to meet new people and connect with cyclists in the community.

These rides occur monthly from March to November and are geared towards newer or non-competitive cyclists. The rides are led by League Cycling Instructors that make the rides safe and sociable while exploring bike-friendly routes throughout Jefferson City.

Locations and start times vary. The monthly ride schedule is posted at jcparks.com/program/community-bike-ride or the JC Parks Facebook page.



Mountain Biking

If you are a mountain bike enthusiast, check out the 15 miles of trail throughout Binder Park and 3.1 miles of the Frog Hollow Nature Trail near the West Edgewood Greenway parking lot.

These trails offer fun for all ages and ability levels and are designed for non-motorized vehicles - ATV's and motorcycles are prohibited. Find maps at jcparks.com/park/mountain-biking/.

Winter Trout Fishing

In conjunction with Capital City Fly Fishers and Missouri Department of Conservation, McKay Lake will be stocked with Rainbow Trout.

November 1 to January 31 is catch and release (artificial baits, no natural or scented baits). Starting February 1, trout may be caught and kept under regulations (any legal bait/lure can be used).

Anglers ages 16-64 must possess a valid fishing permit and a trout stamp. Check out the full regulations by contacting Missouri Department of Conservation at (573) 751-4115 or by visiting mdc.mo.gov.

Fall Hayrides

September 1 - November 30, 2023

Fall hayrides are the perfect opportunity to welcome the changing season with a scenic tour around Binder Park. Hayrides begin with a 30-minute ride to a prepared campfire where your group will have 1.5 hours to enjoy. The hayride ends with an additional 30-minute ride back to the starting point.
