

With our camps being located outdoors in our parks, each camp does not have a direct phone number. However, each camp does use WhatsApp.

WhatsApp group

All camp counselors communicate with parents/guardians using WhatsApp. You must download the app first. Then use this QR code to sign up for our camp community.

Once you have joined the community, you can go to "Groups" and join the group for each week of camp your child(ren) is attending.



Camp Leaders will send out a welcome message each week for camp. If you need to text or call the camp leader for that week, please click on the circle on the bottom left corner of the message.



#### **Weekly Camp Email**

Every Wednesday prior to camp start date, the Camp Director sends an email specific to that camp. This email will include important information regarding your specific camp, camp roster, link to staff bios, and more.



#### **Emergency**

- <u>WhatsApp:</u> If you sign up for the weekly text group, you can call or text the leader.
- If you cannot reach the camp staff using WhatsApp, please call the JC Parks Office @ (573) 634-6482 and ask for the Camp Director, Angie Toebben. Tell the front desk staff that it is an emergency and have them call Angie asap.

- Campers will only be released to a person designated by the parent/guardian to pick them up. Parents—you must include your name(s) on-line using the ePACT form.

# Pick-Up/Drop-Off/Bus Trips

- Green Berry, Camp Frost, Camp Wokka Wokka and Out N About: Participants can be dropped off NO EARLIER than 7:15 a.m.
  - Camp Oakley and Aqua Adventure Camp (at camp site) campers can be dropped off NO EARLIER than 7:30 a.m.
  - Binder (at camp site) campers can be dropped off NO EARLIER than 8:30 a.m.
- All participants must be picked up NO LATER than 5:30pm. Any parent arriving late
  will be given a warning on their first violation, and (thereafter) will be charged \$1.00
  for each minute (he or she) is late. Participants will not be allowed to return to the
  program until this fee is paid. If a parent is late more than three times, the child will
  not be allowed to return to the JC Parks Day Camp program.
- Authorities will be notified if children are not picked up by 6:00 p.m.
- Every child must be signed in & out by a person listed on the child's ePACT medical form.

# Morning Bus Route

If you are dropping off your child at The Linc so they can ride the bus to Camp Oakley, Aqua Adventure Camp, or Binder Adventure Camp, you can drop them off anytime between 7:15-7:45 a.m. You must sign your child in each morning – please go into the lobby of The Linc to drop off your child and sign in with the camp staff.

#### **Daily Schedule for Morning Bus:**

- 7:15 7: 45 a.m.: Drop off at The Linc, 1299 Lafayette Street
- 7:45 8:00 a.m.: Head to Camp Oakley, North Jefferson City
- 8:00 8:15 a.m.: Head to Aqua Adventure Camp, Memorial Park pavilion
- 8:15 8:30 a.m.: Head to Binder Adventure Camp, Binder Park pavilion
  - If you miss The Linc bus or live closer to another camp on the bus route:
     Campers can be dropped off at Camp Oakley or Aqua Adventure Camp as early as 7:30 a.m. to catch the bus as well.
  - Please Note: The morning bus route will not be running the weeks of May 27-30; June 30 - July 3, and August 4-8.

# Pick-Up/Drop-Off/Bus Trips

### **Bus Behavior**

It is our priority to ensure that all campers are safe. In order for a bus ride to be safe, we must be firm regarding misbehavior during trips. If a camper is misbehaving on the bus, for example, using foul language, standing up, disturbing other campers, or not following bus rules, this will result in the following steps to be taken:

- A verbal warning;
- Phone call home;
- Suspended from the following bus trip; and/or
- Expelled from the bus for the remainder of the summer camp season.



# Field Trips

- We transport camp participants on rental school buses. Details and any updates
  will be communicated at the sign in and out table and on the google calendars.
  The times stated on the emails are the times the campers will depart and return
  to camp. Please make sure your camper is on time for departure for field trips.
- While attending field trips our camps operate with a 3-check process for the safety of our campers.
- 1. Counselors are trained in multiple methods to keep campers together. Two examples are the buddy system and assigning a number per camper.
- 2. Managers and Counselors document those in attendance prior to leaving camp and prior to returning to camp.
- 3. This document is checked at the field trip location to ensure all participants are accounted for.

# Cell Phones/Electronics Policy

 Personal/portable electronic devices are not permitted at camp. If a parent believes that their child needs to carry a cell phone for safety reasons as they travel to and from camp, the child may bring the cell phone to camp. However, once they are on camp property, the cell phone must be turned off, put away (not on the camper) and not used during .... (continue reading by scanning QR code)



# **Bullying Policy**

Bullying – In accordance with state law, bullying is defined as intimidation, unwanted aggressive behavior, or harassment that is repetitive or is substantially likely to be repeated and causes a reasonable camper to fear for his or her physical safety or property; that substantially interferes .... # Discipline Policy

- Participants are expected to display satisfactory
  behavior during program hours. If behavior problems
  arise, parents will be contacted. If the problems are
  persistent or severe, the child will be removed from
  the program.

# Clear Bag Policy for Pools

- All camps that go swimming at Memorial Park Family
  Aquatic Center and/or Ellis-Porter Riverside Park, must
  follow the clear bag policy for the pools. This means
  their camp bag with all their supplies must be clear.
- Camper Lunchbox (that fits in the clear camp bag) does not have to be a clear bag.



# Camp Cancellation & Transfer Policies

- Registration fees offset the cost to plan and schedule programs. Our camps depend on enrollments numbers prior to camp start dates. Registering is very important!
- Camp refund policy will be as follows:

## Lost and Found

- Make sure you and your camper are aware of what they bring to camp with them each day. This will help in the prevention of lost and found items at the camp, pool, etc.
- No toys, electronics, ball gloves, trading cards, video games, etc. shall be brought to camp. We cannot assume responsibility for these items.
- Report lost items to the Camp Leader. (continue reading by scanning QR code)





# 1 Camper Injury

In a non-emergency situation, the camper will remain at camp. If first aid is issued to the camper, it will be recorded on an "Ouch Report." (continue reading by scanning QR code)

# **Allergies**

#### **Inclusive Recreation**

If your child requires accommodations for participation, please notify us at least two weeks prior to the week they will attend.



#### **Pool Time & Ice Skating**

On the ePACT medical form, the parent/guardian must select if the camper can swim in the deep end of the pool or not and let us know your child's skate size.

All campers are required to go to swim time or ice-skating time. If you do not wish for them to swim or ice skate, they may sit in the designated camp area with a counselor.



#### **Pool Wristbands**

The camper will be assigned a colored wrist band – Red or Green. Each color is coordinated to the area that camper is allowed to swim in.



# Swimming Lessons at Camp

- Aqua Adventure Camp & Camp Out N About ONLY!
- **REGISTRATION:** Please call the office to register for the coordinating lessons as it can be confusing.
  - This does not have to be done when you register for camp.
- Swim lessons are a separate program not connected with camp.

  If your camper is enrolled in swim lessons during camp, Camp

  Staff will accompany them to the lessons and back to camp.
- As swimming lessons are at 9 am in the morning, please make sure to remind camp staff at check in that your child is enrolled and make sure they are dressed and ready to go to their lesson.

#### **Childcare Statement**



A child care statement will be e-mailed to all camp participants in January. You can also access it in your on-line WebTrac account or by calling 573-634-6482.



#### **License Exempt Disclosure Statement**

Pursuant to Section 210.211.1(4), RSMo., JC Parks Youth Day Camps are exempt from licensing requirements by the State of Missouri. Our camps are registered with the State of Missouri as a Child Care Subsidy Provider. As part of this program, all camp staff must be certified in first aid and CPR, have a fingerprint background check completed every 5 years, must complete at least 6 hours of child care approved training, and all sites are inspected once a year. JC Parks Youth Day Camps also comply with the American Camp Association guidelines.

#### What a Camper Needs:

- Water Bottle
- Clear Bag for all items brought to camp (pool approved)
- Name written/labeled on all items
  - Our lost & found every week is never ending.
- Snack and Sack lunch with a drink— NO GLASS PLEASE! (no fridge available)
- Wear old play clothes—you may get dirty and wet!!
- Closed toe shoes for camp (open toe shoes only allowed at the pool).
- Sun Screen and Bug Spray (spray on).
- Swim wear and towel for swim days (clear bag for pool is required).
- Jacket and long socks for ice skating day.
- Life jacket and water shoes for Camp Green Berry recommended.
- 5 & 6 year old Campers: Extra change of clothing in case of an accident
- Money for pool or ice arena concession stand (optional).
  - We encourage guardians to talk to their children about where to safely keep their money during camp to prevent chances of loss or theft.

# Items Not Allowed at Camp:

- Open toe shoes NO SANDALS or FLIP FLOPS.
- Valuable items that may be lost or broken.
- Electronics: Game Systems, Cell Phones, Toys.
- · Nice clothes.
- Expensive Trading Cards.
- Any type of weapon, sharp object, etc..


#### **Wait Lists**

How does it work? If a camp is full and you are trying to register, it will offer you the option of registering for the wait list. You must register for the wait list in order for us to contact you if a spot opens. There is no charge for the wait list. JC Parks staff will contact you by phone and/or email when and if a spot opens up. We will contact you up until camp begins so if you do not want to remain on the list, please let us know so we can remove you from the waiting list.

# Deferred Payments

If you signed up for the deferred payment plan, you have agreed to pay a minimum of \$25 per camp per week at registration. The final payments are due as follows:

- June camps must be paid in full by May 19.
- July camps must be paid in full by June 16.
- August camps must be paid in full by July 21.


